EAGLES NEST HOUSE INSTRUCTIONS

The house telephone number is: 802-824-6799

The following is the information you will need regarding the Eagles Nest. This will be printed up so that it will be on the refrigerator in Vermont.

To open house you need to do three things; turn on the hot water heater, turn on the water pump and open the water valve to the house. When leaving do the reverse.

- 1. After entering washer/dryer room, while passing the washer/dryer, to the left you will see a "red" hot water switch. Turn it on (when you leave you must turn this off).
- 2. On the right hand wall above the dryer turn on the water pump which is marked with a little white sticker. This switch is in the panel to the upper left of the main electrical box (when you leave you must turn this off).

NEXT:

Enter boiler room, which is the door left of the washer and do the following:

3. One foot in half way down you will see a long red handle. It is marked "house water". Turn this on (when you leave you must turn this off). Please do not touch any other handles, faucets or switches in this room (thank you).

You are now ready to enjoy the house!

THINGS TO KNOW:

- 1. If for any reason you run out of water, inside the boiler room directly to the right of the entrance door you will see switches to the wells north and south. You would switch one of them off and the other one on. Never, never have both wells on at the same time.
- 2. Before leaving the house (for skiing and for the week) make sure that all three thermostats are turned down to at least 50 degrees. Do not go below 50 degrees!
- 3. Always ensure that there are no smoldering ashes in the fireplace before you leave and that the flues are closed. Be very careful with ashes and fires in general.
- 4. Never use bleach in the washing machine or your clothes will be badly discolored.
- 5. Before leaving please make sure all doors and curtains are closed and locked.
- 6. Before leaving please ensure that outdoor lights are turned off.
- 7. The closet in the entryway has a rubber mat on the floor so that you can use this as a ski locker.

- 8. In the event that you need to contact our oil company because of the boiler/heating system, you can contact Johnson Oil at (802) 362-1600 and they will make an emergency service call. Please do not try to fix the heating system yourself (thank you).
- 9. Important telephone numbers are on the refrigerator. Buster is our caretaker and lives in the neighborhood.
- 10. Make sure that there is no food or garbage left any place in the house before you leave, or the field mouse population will surely increase.
- 11. There is a grill on the back, lower deck. Please keep it covered and clean.

Necessary Things to Bring:

- 1. Towels
- 2. Linens or sleeping bags
- 3. Old newspapers to help start fires in the fireplace
- 4. Condiments
- 5. Anything else that will ensure that your basic needs are fulfilled (There are pillows for all bunks).

Please do not call the owner (Larry Allberg his number will be on the refrigerator) unless there is some kind of extraordinary problem. Larry knows that we have a group of people but he has no idea, how many people. The only people he has actually met is Tom and Marcos I do not think he really cares but he might get concerned if the house is really overloaded. The owner has an apartment over the garage. From time to time he will be up on the weekends. If he is there when you are up, please introduce yourself as friends of Marcos and Tom.
